

Identification of the correct Oil Filter to use on Audi, Seat, Skoda and Volkswagen 1.2 and 1.4 Tsi, Tfsi

MAHLE Ref's: OC593/3 and OC593/4

The oil filter is fitted with a top mounted integrated anti-drain system and the flange contains a gasket, which is pushed onto the anti-drain back plate by means of a spring which provides the seal when fitted.

Ensure the seal (as indicated) is correctly fitted as oil leakage could occur and impede the function on the anti-drain system.



Whilst the appearance of both OC593/3 and OC593/4 are similar the sealing gasket is of a different design subsequent sealing

When removing the old filter, please ensure that the old gasket is removed. Experience has shown that there have been instances where the old gasket has been left in situ un-noticed. This means that 2 gaskets are fitted on top of each other with a consequence that the anti-drain valve NO longer functions correctly.

Please note that when fitting the new filter a slightly higher tightening torque 20Nm is required to overcome the spring tension in the anti-drain valve

When removing the used filter, the recesses in the filter ensure that any residual oil drains back into the sump. (Note: Always wait a short period of time to allow oil to drain back fully)
